BIOGRAPHICAL NOTE

Born in Tattnall County, Myrtle Carolyn Outen was the daughter of Johnny J. and Beulah Bazemore Outen. Siblings included Mamie Saturday, Rubye Hollingsworth, Gladys Sapp, Neva Haire, Wilton Outen, Corley Outen, and Vernon Outen. She married Bernease "Skid" Rich and they had two children, a son, Jimmy, and a daughter, Brenda Rich Youmans, deceased.

Mrs. Rich was a very active member of Pine Grove Baptist Church where she attended the Sunshine Sunday School Class and was a member of the WMU. She worked in the Collins High School lunchroom for ten years and was a homemaker. Mrs. Rich was a Grand Matron of the Eastern Star and she loved quilting, crocheting, and sewing.
